NOTE: To earn the MBA and the Juris Doctrate (JD) as a dual degree, you must be admitted to both programs, pursue the degrees concurrently, and meet all requirements for both degrees. Students should complete both degrees at the same time. However, students can receive the first degree as long as all original requirements and credits for the first degree have been met. They then have up to 18 months to complete the second degree. In addition, a student may not apply to the dual degree program after either degree has been awarded. Students must file a formal application with both programs to graduate from both programs. **PLEASE NOTE: JD students will not be graduated and certified to take the bar examination unless both programs have been completed.**

For detailed information, refer to Graduate Student Handbook. An overall GPA of 3.0 is required for MBA graduation. Electives must be graduate (4000-level) courses.
