Entering MSAQF students must meet 3 required prerequisite courses. Students take the prerequisite courses as they complete the MSAQF program and a student's degree plan may range from 45-57 credits. The prerequisite courses are: STAT 4610, ACTG 4610, FIN 4630

¹Students may demonstrate competency in the three prerequisite courses in the following manner:

- Accepted to the MSAQF program through the University of Denver's Undergraduate Master's Accelerated Admissions Process (MAAP) and earned a B or better in the undergrad equivalent course as part of their undergraduate degree program. Undergraduate degree must be in finance.

- Passing an on-campus waiver exam before the start of the MSAQF program.
- Submitting a course syllabus (for completed coursework) for evaluation approval as transfer credit. The course must have been taken less than five years from the date of application for transfer credit.

²Students may substitute another INFO or STAT course for INFO4140 based on their interests and prior coursework and experience.

³Students without coding experience in 'R' should take FIN 4500 before FIN 4830 if possible.

An overall GPA of 3.0 is required for graduation. Electives must be graduate (4000-level) courses.
