This 60-credit online program can be completed in as few as 21 months. Participation in two in-person learning opportunities is required for graduation.

This course sequence pertains to students who are taking two classes per quarter and who are

also pursuing a concentration. Students are able to take classes at their own pace and can choose to pursue the general MBA track instead of choosing a concentration.

Current concentration options available online are: finance, marketing and executive leadership. Additional in-person concentration options are available, including business analytics, accounting, and real estate and the built environment. Students also have the option to complete a customized (self-designed) concentration.
